Important Notes:

1. In **Kentucky**, membership in your state association, KAESP, is required with your NAESP membership.

Associate, \$204 – Available to professors of education or non-administrators. Includes all NAESP benefits and services. EXCLUDES the In-Dues Professional Liability Plan with Legal Benefits Program and voting privilege.
American Student Council Association – Promote youth voice & student leadership in elementary & middle schools. Provide a platform of recognition & support. Dues Options (1) \$50 with Active, Assistant Principal, or Institutional Active membership; or (2) \$75 without an NAESP membership, as shown in (1).
